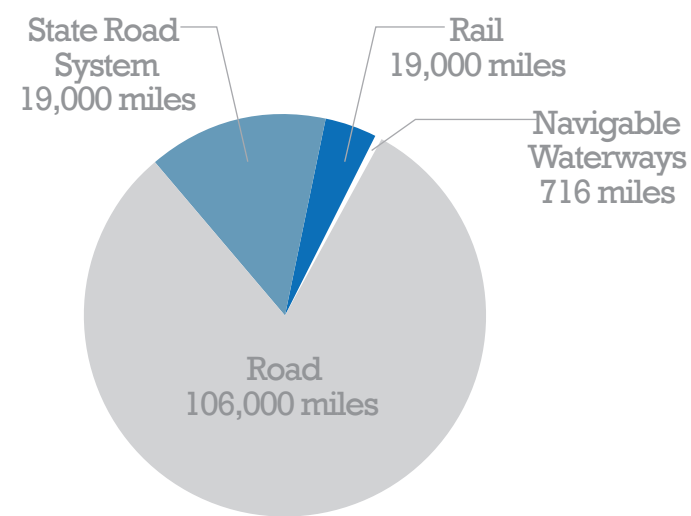

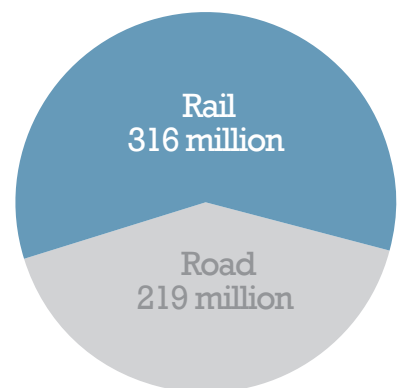
### State Transportation Systems

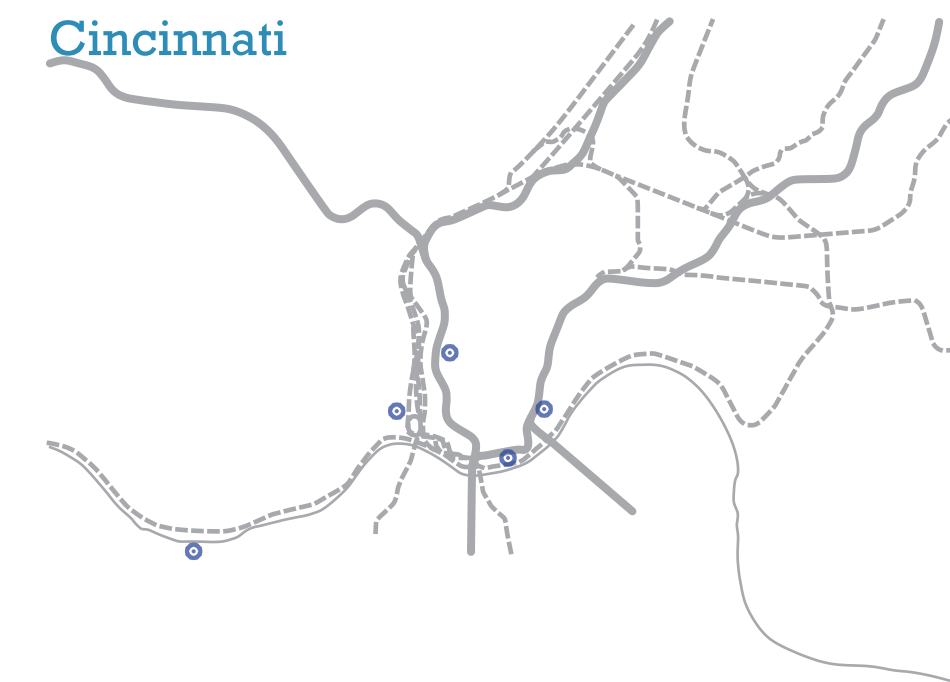

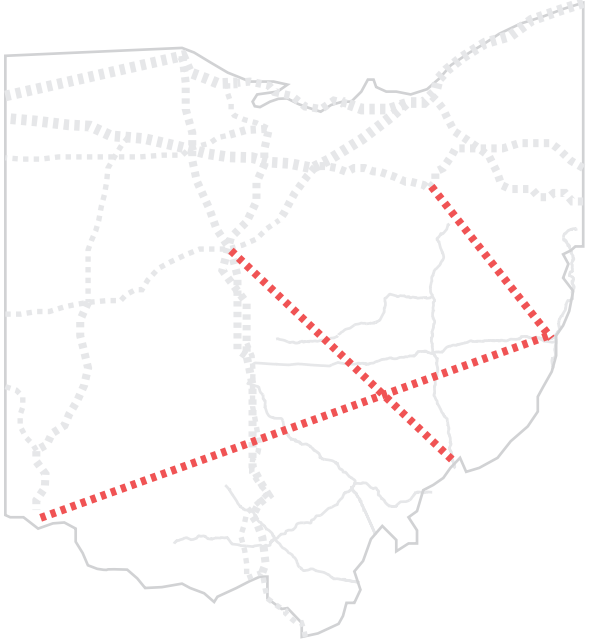
