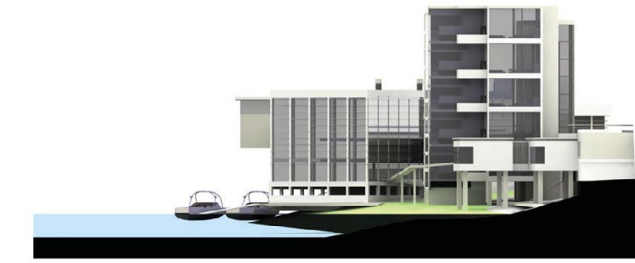

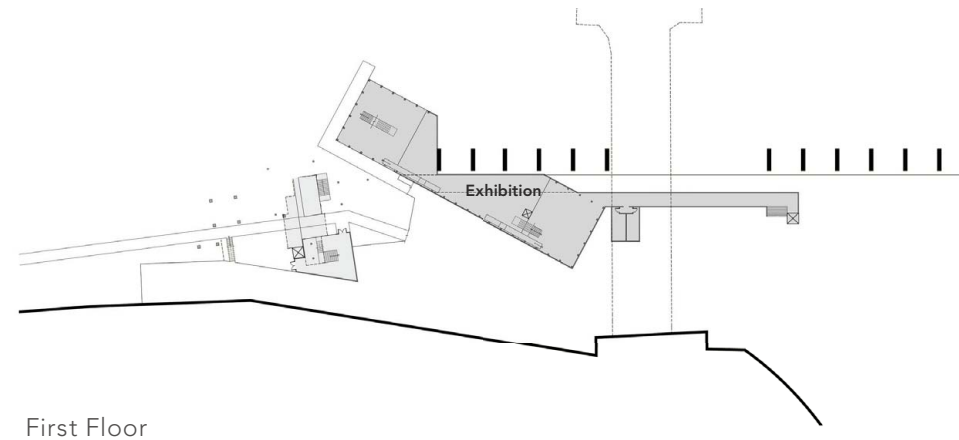

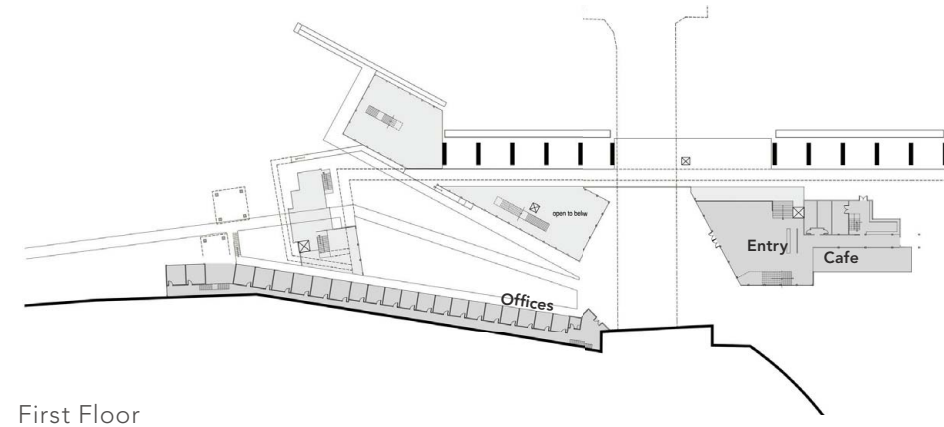
North Elevation



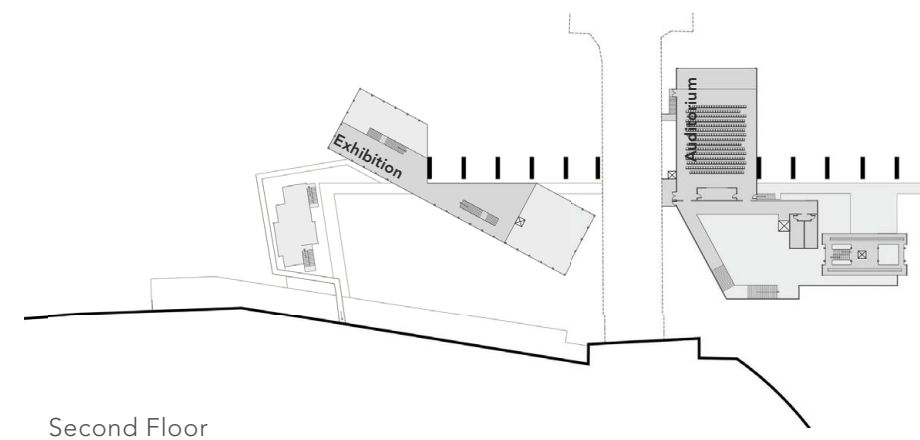
West Elevation

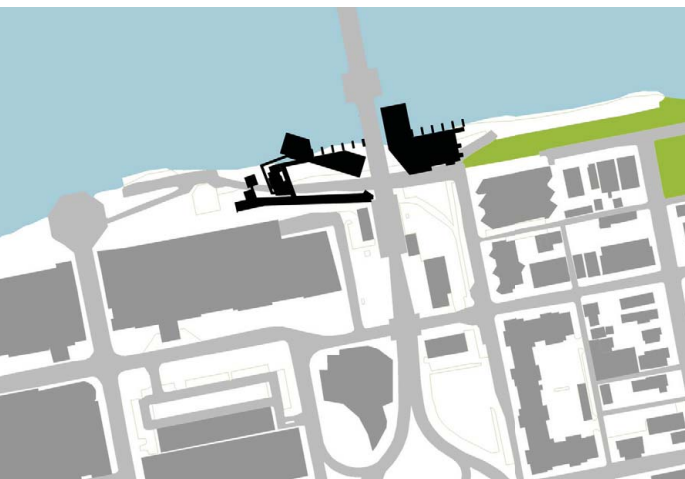
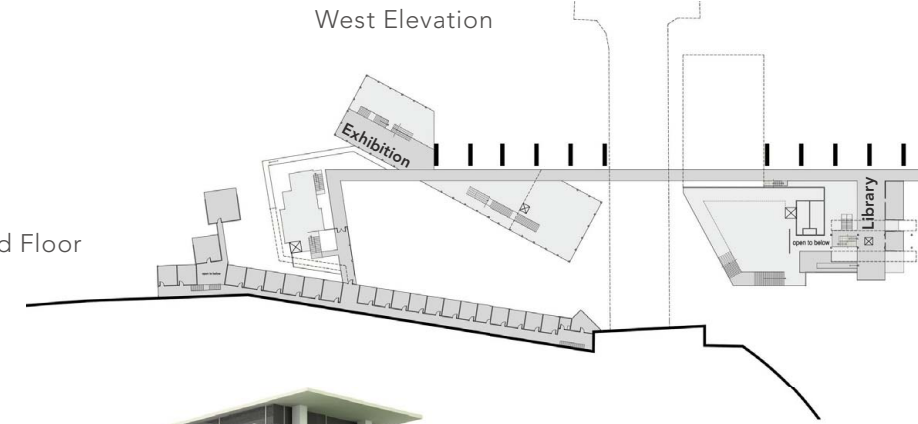
